3 Tips for Safe Planting

1. Use care when operating large machinery near power lines and always keep equipment at least 10 feet away (in all directions) from power lines. Inspect the height of equipment to determine clearance.

2. Remember to lower all extensions.

3. If a power line is sagging or looks to be dangerously low, please call us immediately.
